1 <sup>st</sup> – 2 <sup>nd</sup> grade	50 words minimum
Pre – K – Kind	25 word minimum

## Class Topics

“The Lord’s Army” - Toddler thru 4<sup>th</sup> Grade

### 5<sup>th</sup> Grade and Above

#### The Belt of Truth

In our spiritual walk, the “*belt of truth*” serves the important purpose of keeping the truths found in God’s word & the Gospel message at the center of our lives. This session will address how the word of God should be at the core of your life, remembering to put God First, the importance of knowing God and having a personal relationship with Him.

#### The Breastplate of Righteousness

In our spiritual walk, the “*breastplate of righteousness*” protects us from the attacks on our faith brought on by the enemy, Satan. This class will address protecting your “heart” from unhealthy influences, being internally focused and living your life for Jesus.

#### The Shoes of the Gospel of Peace

Paul encourages us to put on the “*shoes of the Gospel of peace*” so that we may be able to stand firm, prepared to take on any attack Satan may pursue us with, and to walk right for Christ. This session will address how to be confident in your faith, prepared to stand up to peer pressure, bullying and making the right decision, especially when it’s hard to do so.

#### Shield of Faith

Paul encourages us to take up the “*shield of faith*” so we can deflect the “*fiery darts*” the devil flings our way. The session will address protecting your entire body – mind, body and soul for mental/sexual immortality so you can defend your faith.

#### Helmet of Salvation

The helmet served as protection for the soldier’s head, the location from which all thoughts & ideas are birthed & fed. This session will address guarding your mind/”heart” from false doctrines, negative influences (TV, social media, etc), and of the assurance of your salvation.

#### Sword of the Spirit

We’re encouraged to pick up the “*sword of the Spirit*” which is God’s word. This session will address your ability to identify and defend yourself from satanic attacks as well as resources available to you.

#### Armed and Dangerous

This session will discuss the tools needed to remain grounded in the faith now that you are making your own decisions.
